Beginners' Pattern 4066

4066 In a new diagonal wool this Butterick Beginners' Pattern looks like an original French dress. For 36 (size 18), $2\frac{1}{2}$ yards 54-inch sheer wool and $\frac{5}{8}$ yard 35-inch pique. For sizes 14 to 18 and 32 to 44. 45 Cents.

THERE are four outstanding fabrics for fall. That is—four in addition to silk crêpe. Everyone knows that silk crêpe is the standby of the wardrobe every season. And as I have no intention of rambling on about something that everyone knows, this article is devoted to *four other smart fabrics* that you really ought to know about.

Wool—The Smart Wool Frock

You may not have worn wool since the days of your school-going blue serge Peter Thompson, but if you don't have a wool dress this season you are going to feel out of it! *Thin* wool, of course. Four thin wools appeal to me—wool crêpe, open-weave woolen that you can more or less see through, wool with a diagonal weave, and a new rough, bumpy wool that is fine and sheer. Especially this last one, because it is the newest.

The really and truly interesting thing about the woolen dress is its color. Due to the influence of the French Colonial Exposition, which brought to the attention of the fabric makers some gorgeous shades, we are going to wear bright strong colors. There is rust red and raspberry red. Dusty yellow and mustard. Dull orange. Middle blue. Sage green (wear brown accessories with this if you want a perfectly beautiful costume). And bright primitive green. You can wear much more vivid colors in wool than you think you can, for the dull woolen surface dims the color a bit, tones it down. I predict that you will find yourself wearing colors in wool this year that you wouldn't in your wildest moments dream of wearing in silk!

In addition to the bright wools, these three quieter ones are chic—black wool worn with white accents, brown wool, and beige wool.

Silk-and-Wool—The "Street Prints"

Silk-and-wool crêpe looks like an exceptionally heavy all-silk canton faille. It is part woolen, however. And to me the real point about this fabric is its non-wrinkling quality. You can travel in it all day and it looks as fresh at the end of the journey as it did when you started. The silk-and-wools are

in dark colors, printed with small all-over white designs, usually in tweed patterns. "Street prints" is one name for them, "travel prints" another.

Satin—Especially Black Satin

Black satin has come back. It's smartest, I think, when made up in a rather tailored style—at least, it looks newest that way. And it is almost always accompanied with a touch of white. I am thinking now of a black satin dress which has one *white* rever and one *black* one, and I've seen the very same frock with one white rever and one *red* one.

For evening three satins are in great favor. White satin—black satin—beige satin. White satin is just as smart as ever. Black makes some of the slinkiest, most sophisticated evening gowns you ever saw. As for beige satin, Patou makes it up for dinner dresses and other semi-evening frocks that would look much too dressed-up if made of white satin.

Velvet—Velvet Dresses, Velvet Suits

Velvet is smart for afternoon frocks, for afternoon suits, for evening gowns. Brown, black and wine red are smart velvet colors for the afternoon frock. Black velvet and brown velvet are preferred for suits. Ivory is my choice for the evening dress.
